The Bedford County Historical Society is sponsoring a bus trip to Harrisburg on Thursday, May 24, 2018. We will visit the State Museum of Pennsylvania and the State Archives. Please pack a lunch, and dinner will be at the Middlesex Diner in Carlisle, PA.

About the museum: Exhibits include Pennsylvania Icons, a new exhibit featuring over 350 items showing how PA has uniquely influenced the nation's development, Anthropology and Archaeology Gallery, Transportation & Industry, Objects of Valor: Commemorating the Civil War in PA, Hall of Geology, Life Through Time, Mammal Hall, and Ecology Hall.

The State Archives houses a collection of over 250,000,000 documents, beginning with William Penn's original charter. Visitors can request to see State Land Records, Transportation and Industrial Records, Genealogical Records (which include Bedford County Courthouse Records that have been sent to the state for safekeeping), and more.

The cost is \$50 for members, and \$60 for non-members. Your fee includes the bus and admission. You are responsible for all meals. This is a great opportunity for genealogists/researchers in our area.
