

Attention: Bedford County High School Seniors

Important Reminder!

Eligibility:

A student must have at least a two year residency in a Bedford County, PA and graduate from any high school (public, private, or home school) within Bedford County, PA.

A fund has been established and is managed by the Community Foundation of the Alleghenies; the annual award of \$750.00 is now made available through the Bedford County Historical Society.

How to apply:

A student planning to apply for this history award must register with the Bedford County Historical Society, during their junior or senior year in high school.

The topic is of the student's own choosing, and must be approved by the Bedford County Historical Society.

Important Information/ Date:

An informational packet will be provided by the Bedford County Historical Society, which includes: an application, instructions to complete the necessary forms, established parameters for a research project, as well as, various criteria.

All the aforementioned; including the research project (documented paper and exhibit/ display) must be completed and submitted on or before April 30, 2020.

Primary Focus:

The intent of this fund is to assist in furthering the education of a young mind in developing valuable skills, either through a history related major in college or at a trade or vocational school; utilizing and applying those talents in a profession, dealing with the preservation of American History.
